These two items would be a tremendous help to him and to us as we serve the Lord here in the Cajamarca area.

Soul-Winning Campaign!

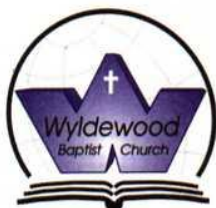
