We had a revival meeting from December 6-9 with missionary Andrés Amoros from Santo Domingo. We had a wonderful time with a high attendance of 70 people on the last day. During the week, we saw six people get saved and had two rededications in the church services. The altar was full each night with members and visitors making decisions. It was a wonderful week,

and we now have six new baby Christians that need to be baptized. Amen!

Please continue to pray about our need for another bus. Our bus route has grown to over 180 people. We desperately need another bus. We have had to divide our Sunday school into two services (A service and B service), and we are already beginning to reach the point where we will need to add a "C" Sunday school hour. A good used bus will cost us about \$400,000.00 pesos if we bought it here. That is the equivalent of \$11,111.00 dollars at the current exchange rate. It would be less expensive, and we could get a better vehicle, if we were able to purchase a good school bus in the states and ship it down here. The bus will have to be a 1999 model or newer to be able to ship it into the country. It also needs to have a diesel engine since diesel is so much cheaper than gasoline.
